

Dee's Music Room Studio Policy



Tuition

Tuition for lessons are due by the month in advance on the 1st of the month, with a \$25 late fee after the 10th. Your student's monthly tuition is the same level amount each month and includes 46 lessons per calendar year plus participation in recitals. Your student's lesson is a level rate of \$155 for 30 min, \$233 for 45 min, or \$310 for 1 hr. per month. Payment options include: PayPal, Zelle, Credit Card, or mailed check. Check with your teacher to find the way he/she likes to be paid.

Parent/Student Responsibility

A student contracts the teacher's time at enrollment. The student is expected to be present for the lesson time which is assigned for him or her. Only lessons cancelled at least 24 hours in advance (notification of illness or family emergency excepted) will be rescheduled, in consideration of the instructor's schedule. No refunds will be made. Group lessons cannot be rescheduled or made up. Students may also attend another class of the same type if it is available. If a student is not picked up within 15 minutes of the end of his/her lesson, the teacher must stay with the student until pickup, and the teacher is to charge hourly teaching rate for the time they must wait. Under no circumstances is forgetfulness, lack of preparation or social conflicts a valid excuse for a rescheduled lesson. An attitude of respect for teachers, for other students and for property in the studio is expected at all times. In person, parents must wait for students under 8 years. If parents have younger children with them, the children must stay with parents at all times. We appreciate your assistance in keeping lessons of the other students uninterrupted. It is suggested that if 2 students come to class with one parent, if behavior in class becomes disruptive and difficult to manage, another adult may be required during classtime. If there are more than 2 students in a family, another adult is needed during classtime.

It is in the best interest of the student that we have regular lessons so their progress is steady. Parental support and guidance helps a student learn how to allocate practice time and accomplish weekly goals. Sometimes being with a student when he or she first starts the habit of practice will help the student take ownership of both practice and performance, and that is rewarding for all of us!

Holidays, Weather or Earth Events

No lessons will be held on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. Your teacher will inform students and parents if he or she plans to be absent a month in advance, unless it is an emergency. Weather: If Northshore Public Schools are closed due to bad weather or earth events such as earthquakes, etc., the studio will be closed as well. Every attempt will be made to make up missed lessons and classes. Two lessons a week in summer is certainly a great way to make progress, and summer can provide us with a chance for this opportunity if makeups are not available during the school year, or we have included a list of school teacher work days.

Summer Study

Summer lessons are vital to keeping those fingers or that voice or violin or guitar strumming! At least 6 weeks lessons are suggested during the summer months, and since tuition continues regularly during summer months, teachers are creative in getting your lessons in when you are in town.
